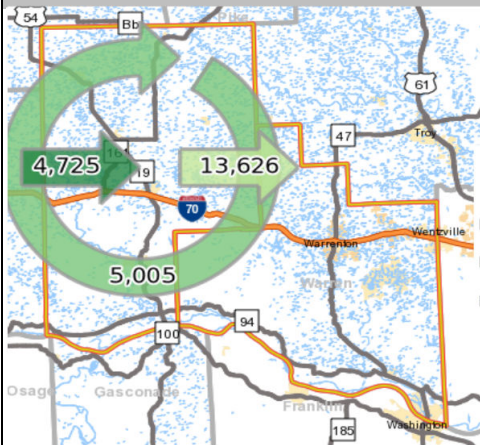

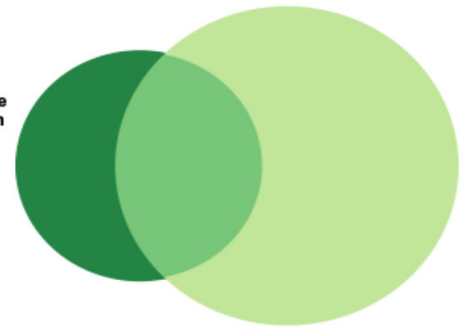


Analysis Selection
